### Rules and why we have them

The children have been learning about how rules can help to keep the world fair and can help to keep us safe.

We looked at some of the rules in school and briefly at some traffic rules (we shall be looking in more detail at this later in the programme)

### Safe Strangers

First, we talked about how we shouldn't talk to strangers when we are on our own.

Next, we talked about whether there might ever be a time when we needed to talk to a stranger (if we get lost for example).
