MESSAGE FROM CHRIST THE KING SCHOOL - EXAMINATION RESULTS 2022

We are very proud of the achievements of all our students, especially given the disruptions they have faced in their learning over the last few years. They have shown a great commitment to their studies and it has resulted in some fantastic results – well done to you all! Year 13 results: 35.1% of students gained A*-B grades and 95.3% gained A*-E grades.
 GCSE results: 73% of our students achieved grades 4 or above in Maths and English; 69% of our students achieved at least 5 grades 4 or above including English and Maths. We couldn't be more proud of the results that our students have achieved.
