Why do we need a skeleton?

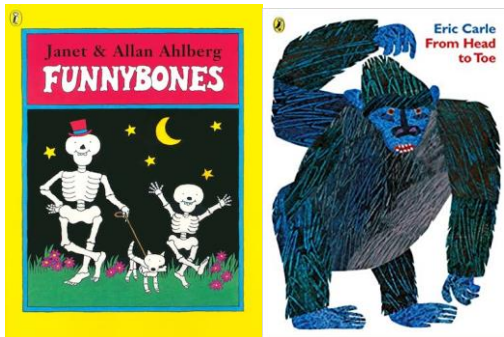

### ELG: The Natural World

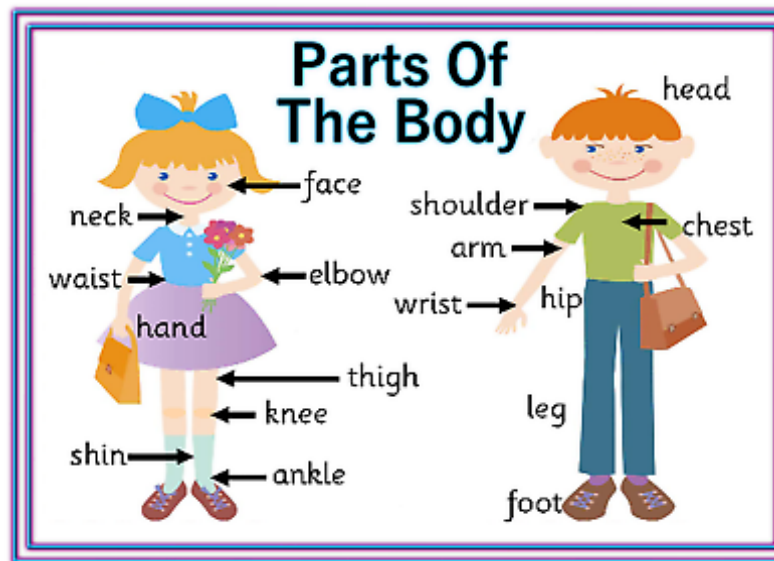
Children at the expected level of development will:

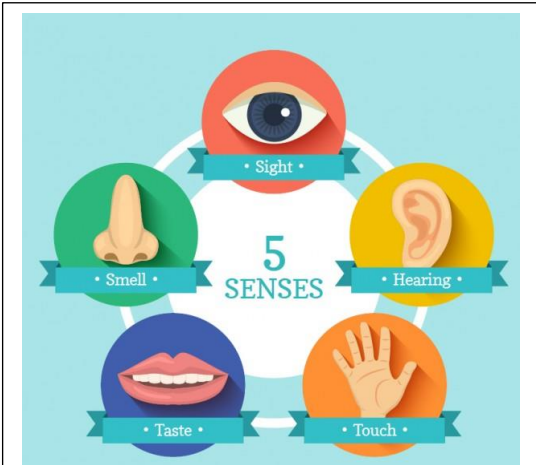
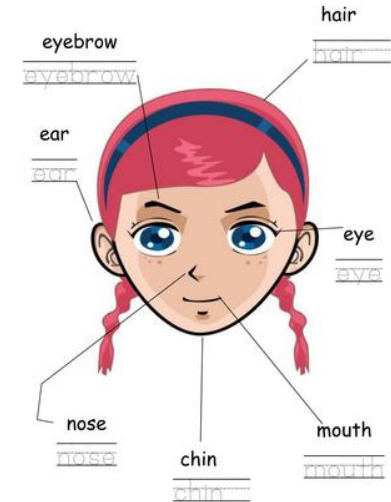
