



## Subject Coverage Overview

**Geography** is the study of places and the relationship between people and their environments.



Nine **key concepts (disciplinary concepts)** of geography repeat throughout the curriculum.

(In brackets, you will see other important related concepts - Substantive Concepts).

These provide lenses through which to consider the different aspects of geography:

**boundaries** (continents, localities, nations) **Movement of People**

**cartography** (atlases, directions, distance, Equator, latitude, longitude, North/South Pole, maps, scale, symbols)

**change** (adaptation, sustainability) **Conservation**

**climate** (climate change, climate zones, pollution, weather) **Conservation**

**interdependence** (economy, trade) **Community / Social Justice**

**movement** (migration, navigation, transport) **Movement of People**

**physical geography** (biomes, bodies of water, tectonics, topography)

**resources** (energy, food supply, infrastructure) **Farming**

**settlements** (population, rural areas, urban areas) **Movement of People**
