



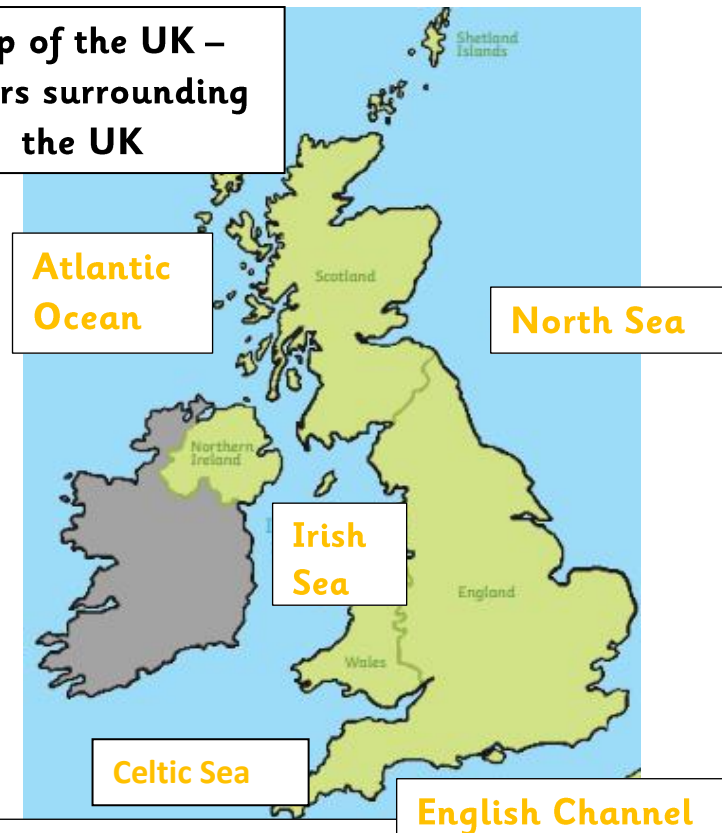
Geography – Water

Geography is the study of places and the relationships between people and their environments.

Vocabulary

Reservoir	a large natural or artificial lake used as a source of water supply.
Lake	a large area of water surrounded by land.
River	a large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea, or another river.
Sea	the salt water that covers most of the earth's surface and surrounds its land masses.
Ocean	a very large expanse of sea, in particular, each of the main areas into which the sea is divided geographically.
Coast	the part of the land adjoining or near the sea.
Island	a piece of land surrounded by water.
