


Geography - Water

Vocabulary

a large natural or artificial lake used as a source of water supply.
a large area of water surrounded by land.
a large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea, or another
river.
the salt water that covers most of the earth's surface and surrounds its
land masses.
a very large expanse of sea, in particular, each of the main areas into
which the sea is divided geographically.
the part of the land adjoining or near the sea.
a piece of land surrounded by water.
