Please could I ask that you continue to keep one of our teaching assistants, Mrs Williams, in your thoughts and prayers at this time. Mrs Williams continues to be on long term sickness absence from school.

Jewellery

Just a reminder to everyone that no jewellery is to be worn for PE lessons. If your child is unable to independently take their earrings out, please can parents take their child's earrings out the morning of PE. If there are any individual concerns, please speak to Mr Priestley. If you are planning on having your child's ears pierced, could you aim for this to be done at the start of the summer holidays if possible. Please ensure your child does not come to school wearing any other jewellery including bracelets, necklaces, etc. We would prefer small studs for school and will accept small hooped earrings.

Nail Polish/Tattoos

We still have some children coming to school with tattoos and nail polish. We understand that children attend parties during the weekends, but please could parents ensure any tattoos and nail polish have been removed for Monday. Thank you.

Hair Accessories

Please ensure that any hair accessories your child is wearing are school colours - blue, black or white.

School Shoes/Trainers

Please ensure your child is wearing black school schools and trainers for PE days. We expect children to wear either black, navy or white trainers. Please do not send children to school in expensive branded or brightly coloured trainers. We have a few children who have been coming in to school wearing trainers. If you are waiting for new school shoes to arrive, please inform the office or your child's class teacher, as your child will be asked why they are wearing trainers if it is not a PE day.

School Uniform

After half term, we ask that children come to school wearing their winter uniform, as this is when the weather turns cooler.

Catholic Life

Father Richard will be in school most Fridays after half term, as we will be introducing the children to Class Mass. Each class will be on a rota for celebrating Mass in their classroom and parents will be informed of when their child's Mass will be, as parents and parishioners are welcome to attend.
