This Wednesday 22nd February is Ash Wednesday and the start of Lent. Lent is a period of 40 days and reminds us of when Jesus fasted in the dessert. It is a time when we remember the love of God that is poured out through Christ Jesus on the cross in His death and sacrifice for us.

We will have a whole school Ash Wednesday Liturgy, where all of the children will receive the ashes.

Altar servers

Before half term, we welcomed Michael Hallam in to school to talk with our Year 4, 5 and 6 children about whether they would be interested in training at Holy Cross Church to become an altar server. Michael explained his role at Holy Cross Church as an altar server and showed the children his gold medal that he received from the Bishop for his 50 years of service as an altar server. If your child does attend Holy Cross Church and is interested in training to be an altar server, please do let Michael or Father Richard know. Father Richard is then also able to support the training of children as altar servers during class Mass at school every Friday morning.

First Holy Communion

First Holy Communion classes will commence this week. The first meeting will be this **Thursday 23rd February at 6pm** in the little room at the back of church. The children are not required to attend this first meeting. The children will make their First Holy Communion on **Saturday 17th June at 11am** at Holy Cross Church. We are very blessed to have a supportive group of parents in Year 3 who are leading the classes at Holy Cross Church this year.

Non school uniform day - Response to Emergency Turkey-Syria earthquake appeal

This **Friday 24th February**, we will be having a non-school uniform day to raise money for CAFOD. We are inviting children to bring £1 in exchange for wearing non-school uniform. Parents and Friends group will be collating this money, as we are now a cashless school, and they operate a separate bank account. The money raised will go towards the Turkey-Syria earthquake appeal where it is now reported around 46,000 people have lost their lives. This is reflected in our curriculum work linked to Fairtrade fortnight which starts 27^{th} February – 12^{th} March. Staffing update:

This term, we have welcomed Mr Charles Archer to our Trust schools as a school Chaplain. This means we now have Lucy Trealor and Charles Archer who are both school Chaplains based at Christ the King secondary school, but spend half a day a week in the feeder Catholic primary schools. The children will have the opportunity to work with both Lucy and Charles throughout the academic year.

Wrap Around Care Provision

This is to ensure Ms Bales is aware of staffing requirements or if you need to cancel the booking. Please pre-book if you are able to ensure a place. We will not be able to accept any bookings after 1.00pm to ensure we have the correct staff/children ratio as the after school club is reaching maximum capacity most nights.

School Uniform (Forest Schools)

It has been agreed that we will be changing the Forest School day T-shirt to either a navy blue or black T-shirt. Your child will no longer be expected to wear a white T-shirt for Forest School day. This uniform change will come in to immediate effect starting this week as we return to school.

Price and Buckland now have a Forest school T-shirt with the school logo on of you wish to purchase this for Forest school days. Alternatively, a plain black or navy T-shirt will be accepted too. We do not accept T-shirts that are branded or have other writing on as part of school uniform.

Our PE T-shirt will continue to be a white T-shirt. This is available with the school logo on from Price and Buckland or you can send your child in a plain white unbranded T-shirt. Please do not send your child wearing a T-shirt with writing on, as this is on accepted as part of school uniform.

We have a few children who have been coming in to school wearing trainers. If you are waiting for new school shoes to arrive, please inform the office or your child's class teacher, as your child will be asked why they are wearing trainers if it is not a PE day.

Any lost property that remains in school for more than half a term is taken to the charity shop.

This will be split with each class having some to spend on new books for their reading area, the nurture room, EYFS and then the rest will be spent on updating and refreshing the school library. Any books which were sold out at the fair but have been paid for have been ordered. These will be sent out to children as soon as they arrive in school. A really big thank you for all the support, it's fantastic to see so many children with their heads buried in books!

Winners of the story writing competition

Ollie in Year 6 and Claire in Year 2 were the key stage winners and Abigail in Year 4 was the runner up. It was fantastic to see children getting involved in writing some really imaginative stories and I know teachers were really impressed with the children who entered too.
