

### **Catholic Life**

Lasting fifty days, the season of Easter, also known as Eastertide, is a time for celebrating new life. # Road safety and parking

Just an ongoing polite reminder to ask our parents to park considerately on the roads around our school. I have had a couple of parents raise concerns about cars parking on the grass verges on the corner of Ethel Avenue. The neighbours have raised concerns that the tyre marks from the cars are damaging the grass verges.

Can I also ask parents to ensure our children arrive safely into school by ensuring that children are not crossing the road by themselves. There have still been a couple of incidents where parents are stopping their car on the other side of the road and allowing children to get out of the car and cross the road unsupervised. This is not safe and could parents kindly get out of the car to see your child safely across the road and into school. Some parents have expressed their concerns to me when witnessing other parents doing this. Thank you for your co-operation with trying to keep all of our children safe.

Just a reminder that there is still an open vacancy for a school crossing patrol person that has yet to be filled.

### Nursery

Our new Nursery is steadily starting to increase in numbers. Please spread the word to any family and friends who are looking for Nursery places that we now have a Nursery at Holy Cross and there are spaces available. We can offer wrap around care for our Nursery children for any parents who need that additional childcare support before and after school.

# **Assessment arrangements**

This term, we have several children who will be completing their statutory assessments in Year 1, Year 2, Year 4 and Year 6. Below are the dates for parents to be aware of:

- Year 6 KS2 SATS Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> May Friday 12<sup>th</sup> May
- Year 2 KS1 SATS Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May (Completed over 2 weeks)
- Year 1 Phonics Screening Check Monday 12th June Friday 16th June
- Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June

Please ensure you try to avoid making any appointments during the school day during your child's assessment weeks.

Class teachers will continue to keep parents informed of how you can be supporting your child at home for completing their statutory assessments.

# **End of year school reports**

Your child's school report will be shared on **Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July**. During the week beginning 10<sup>th</sup> July, there will be an opportunity for you to discuss any concerns from your child's report with the class teacher. This is not a Termly Learning meeting, and **is only if you need to discuss something specific within the report.**

# **Mobile Phones in school (Parents)**

Before the first COVID lockdown, and as part of our Safeguarding procedures, we had a 'no mobile phones' policy in school when parents came in for events, such as assemblies, workshops, etc. We would like to return to this expectation and politely ask that once any parents come in to school through main Reception, that mobile phones are not out on show.

We used to also request that parents did not collect their child from the playground whilst talking on their mobile phone. Again, this is something we would like to return to (unless it is an emergency call you are receiving). We will arrange for signage around school to remind parents of this.

# **School Uniform (Forest Schools)**
