Class Masses

Healthy eating

Just a reminder for any of our children who bring their own packed lunch box to school. We do try to encourage our children to be healthy eaters and to eat a range of different food types. We have noticed recently that there are larger sized chocolate bars being sent in to school, as well as the child having biscuits **and** cake as well for lunch. Please see below for some ideas of healthy alternatives to chocolate bars, biscuits and cakes for lunchtime:













We have always said no to sweets being brought in for lunchtime and due to allergies in school, we are a nut free school.

Please could you try to limit your child's amount of sugar intake at lunchtime to just one sugary item, such as one cake OR one small chocolate bar OR one packet of biscuits.

We understand that some children have limited food choices, so we will always try to work with our families as best we can to support with healthier choices.

Sun safety

As the weather is starting to warm up and we are having more sunny days, please could you start applying sun cream to your child before school and send them to school with a named sun hat. You are also welcome to send a small bottle of sun cream with your child's name on to keep in their bag so that they can re-apply at lunchtime if required. There are all day sun cream protection alternatives available too.

Road safety and parking

Just an ongoing polite reminder to ask our parents to park considerately on the roads around our school and to please check you are not blocking any resident's driveways.

Can I also ask parents to ensure our children arrive safely into school by ensuring that children are not crossing the road by themselves. There have still been a couple of incidents where parents are stopping their car on the other side of the road and allowing children to get out of the car and cross the road unsupervised. This is not safe and could parents kindly get out of the car to see your child safely across the road and into school. Some parents have expressed their concerns to me when witnessing other parents doing this. Thank you for your co-operation with trying to keep all of our children safe.

School Crossing Patrol Officer

Nursery

Our new Nursery is steadily starting to increase in numbers. We have appointed Miss Parker to cover Miss Duong's maternity leave. Miss parker has been working at Holy Cross as a supply teacher during these past few months, so she has already had the opportunity to teach some of our classes and get to know the children and the Holy Cross Way expectations.

Assessment arrangements

Well done to our Year 6 pupils who have now completed their end of Key Stage Two SATs! This term, we have several children who are completing their statutory assessments in Year 1, Year 2, Year 4 and Year 6. Below are the dates for parents to be aware of:

- Year 2 KS1 SATS Monday 15th May (Completed over 2 weeks)
- Year 1 Phonics Screening Check Monday 12th June Friday 16th June
- Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check Monday 5th June Friday 16th June

Please ensure you try to avoid making any appointments during the school day during your child's assessment weeks.

End of year school reports

Your child's school report will be shared on **Friday 7**th **July**. During the week beginning 10th July, there will be an opportunity for you to discuss any concerns from your child's report with the class teacher. This is not a Termly Learning meeting, and **is only if you need to discuss something specific within the report.**

Term-time holidays

Please note that we cannot authorise any absence from school for family holidays during term-time. Further information can be found on our website and in the Attendance Policy. If your child's holiday absence amounts to a certain number of days, we are required to pass this information to the Education Welfare Officer at the Local Authority and you may be issued with a penalty notice.

Mobile Phones in school (Parents)

Before the first COVID lockdown, and as part of our Safeguarding procedures, we had a 'no mobile phones' policy in school when parents came in for events, such as assemblies, workshops, etc. We would like to return to this expectation and politely ask that once any parents come in to school through main Reception, that mobile phones are not out on show.

We used to also request that parents did not collect their child from the playground whilst talking on their mobile phone. Again, this is something we would like to return to (unless it is an emergency call you are receiving). We will arrange for signage around school to remind parents of this.

School Uniform (Summer)

We are now in the term where our school uniform for children in Year 1 – 6 changes to the summer uniform. This includes a blue polo shirt, grey shorts and blue gingham dress. The uniform remains the same for our children in the Early Years, other than they can wear navy/black shorts on warm days. We appreciate that on cooler days, children will still need to wear their winter uniform. Please use your own discretion on when to allow your child to wear summer clothing.

School Uniform (Forest Schools)

Just a reminder that we changed the Forest School day T-shirt to either a navy blue or black T-shirt. Your child is no longer expected to wear a white T-shirt for Forest School day.

Price and Buckland have a Forest school T-shirt with the school logo on of you wish to purchase this for Forest school days. Alternatively, a plain black or navy T-shirt will be accepted too. We do not accept T-shirts that are branded or have other writing on as part of school uniform.

Our PE T-shirt will continue to be a white T-shirt. This is available with the school logo on from Price and Buckland or you can send your child in a plain white unbranded T-shirt. Please do not send your child wearing a T-shirt with writing on, as this is on accepted as part of school uniform.

School shoes / Trainers

Please ensure your child is wearing black school shoes or trainers for PE days. We expect children to wear either black, navy or white trainers. Please do not send children to school in expensive branded or brightly coloured trainers, as these are not part of school uniform.

We have a few children who have been coming in to school wearing trainers. If you are waiting for new school shoes to arrive, please inform the office or your child's class teacher, as your child will be asked why they are wearing trainers if it is not a PE day.

Used uniform

Our school governors collected in used uniform that is available to be distributed to other families. Please let the school office know if you are in need of any school uniform and would like to access the used uniform. Any lost property that remains in school for more than half a term is taken to the charity shop.
