ST MARGARET CLITHEROW CATHOLIC ACADEMY: FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2023: Our First Holy Communion candidates from St Margaret Clitherow Academy will celebrate their First Holy Communion **next Saturday 13th May at Our Lady’s Church**. Please remember them in prayer as they take this most important step on their journey of faith. Please also remember their parents, godparents, teachers, catechists, and all who are supporting them on this step in their faith journey.

RECEIVING COMMUNION UNDER BOTH KINDS: A gentle reminder; after receiving the Host, can you please consume immediately. If you wish to receive the Precious Blood, approach the Eucharistic Minister who will say ‘The Blood of Christ’. We respond ‘Amen’ and take hold of the Chalice, sip and then give it back to the Minister. The Minister will wipe the chalice after each person and rotate so the next person sips from a different side. **The practice of Intinction (dipping the Host into the Precious Blood) is not permitted under any circumstances.**

THE CORONATION OF KING CHARLES III will take place in Westminster Abbey **this Saturday 6th May**. As faithful citizens of our countries, we now pray for our King as he assumes the fullness of his responsibility. Prayer cards are available at the back of church.
