## Catholic Life

The Christian holiday of **Pentecost** is celebrated on the 50th day from Easter Sunday. It commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and other followers of Jesus Christ while they were in Jerusalem celebrating the Feast of Weeks, as described in the Acts of the Apostles. Last weekend, the Church celebrated the Feast of Pentecost.

The name of the day itself is derived from the Greek word "pentecoste," meaning 50th.

Pentecost is considered the birthday of the Church - Peter, the first Pope, preaches for the first time and converts thousands of new believers. The apostles and believers, for the first time, were united by a common language, and a common zeal and purpose to go and preach the Gospel.

#### End of year school reports

Your child's school report will be shared on **Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July**. During the week beginning 10<sup>th</sup> July, there will be an opportunity for you to discuss any concerns from your child's report with the class teacher. This is not a Termly Learning meeting, and **is only if you need to discuss something specific within the report.** 

#### **Attendance and Punctuality**

Learning time for children starts when the gates are locked from 8:45am. The children have morning tasks to complete during register time, which may be their corrections from the previous day's work or activities that allow retrieval practice from previous learning.

Most of the children at Holy Cross have excellent attendance and punctuality. We understand that for some of our children with additional needs, we do support families where there are medical reasons that impact attendance or can affect a child's punctuality. However, if your child does not have additional medical needs, we do expect all children who are well to be in school and arriving on time. Following the pandemic, we are passionate to ensure our children are in school as often as they can be, to try and reduce any future missed learning in school.

To improve punctuality and attendance for all our children, we would like to request the following things:

- Any routine medical and dental appointments to be made outside of the school day (If possible).
- Where medical or dental appointments are not routine and instead are hospital based or 'treatment focused' please email a photo of the appointment letter or show a copy to the office. This is so that this can be recorded as 'authorised absence'.
- Where punctuality in the morning is a recurrent issue, we will seek to meet with families to see if this can be resolved.
- Children should not be taken out of school for holidays during term time. Parents who take their children out of school during term time may be issued with a penalty notice.

# Term-time holidays

Please note that we cannot authorise any absence from school for family holidays during term-time. Further information can be found on our website and in the Attendance Policy. ## School Uniform (Summer)

We are now in the term where our school uniform for children in Year 1 – 6 changes to the summer uniform. This includes a blue polo shirt, grey shorts and blue gingham dress. The uniform remains the same for our children in the Early Years, other than they can wear navy/black shorts on warm days. We appreciate that on cooler days, children will still need to wear their winter uniform. Our Reception children may wear navy blue, grey or black shorts with their school T-shirt.
