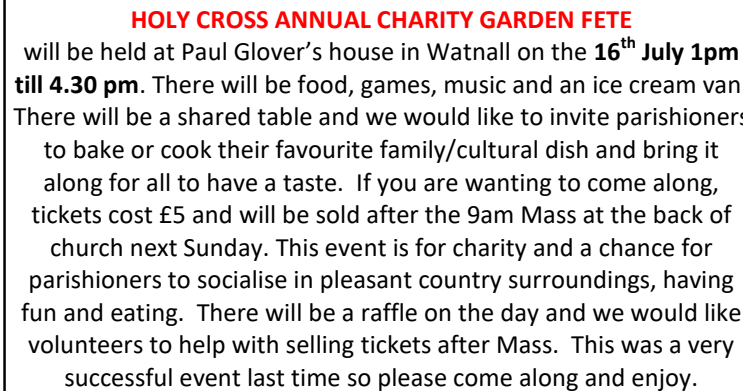
We would like to thank the teachers and students from Our Lady's Primary Academy who have provided and planted our flower pots around our church and hall. They look beautiful and brighten up the area.
