Welcome back to the new academic year! I hope you have enjoyed your family summer break. We are very much looking forward to welcoming our children back to school and supporting them in their new class year group school routines.

Staffing updates

Mrs Tipton has returned from maternity leave to continue full-time in her role as Deputy Headteacher and school Special Educational Needs co-ordinator. We are grateful to Mrs Bruce and Miss Duong for their additional leadership commitments during the time of Mrs Tipton's maternity leave.

Forest Schools

Mrs Hudson will be continuing to lead our children's Forest Schools sessions fortnightly. Mrs Hudson will continue to share information linked to Forest Schools on the class pages of Dojo.

PE Lessons

We will continue to have Mr Woolley teaching our Year 5 and 6 children PE lessons. Mr Woolley will then continue with the after schools sports club and specific year groups will receive an information letter regarding this.

New class information

Your child's class teacher will be sharing a welcome video with you this week. This will be a short video to introduce themselves to you and to share some key information that you will need for the start of the new term. If you have any follow up questions, please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher via Class Dojo.

Class Dojo communication

We will aim to only communicate with families via Class Dojo between the working hours of the school day. It should only be in emergency situations or short notice messages if you receive any communication after 6pm or during the weekend.

If you contact a member of staff after 6pm, please do not expect a response until at least the following working day.

You are always welcome to Dojo myself or Mrs Tipton if there is a more urgent or Safeguarding concerns.

Jewellery

Please could you note that we request no jewellery is to be worn for PE lessons. If your child is unable to independently take their earrings out, please can parents take their child's earrings out the morning of PE.

Please ensure your child does not come to school wearing any other jewellery including bracelets, necklaces, etc. We would prefer small studs for school and will accept small hooped earrings.

Nail polish and tattoos

Towards the end of last term, we noticed an increase in children coming to school with tattoos and nail polish. We understand that children attend parties during the weekends, but please could parents ensure any tattoos and nail polish have been removed for Monday.

Hair accessories

Please ensure that any hair accessories your child is wearing are school colours – blue, black or white.

School shoes / Trainers

Please ensure your child is wearing black school schools and trainers for PE days. We expect children to wear either black, navy or white trainers. Please do not send children to school in expensive branded or brightly coloured trainers.

Father Richard will be celebrating Mass for the Feast of the Holy Cross at Church on **Wednesday 14**th **September at 10am**. Parents and family members are welcome to join us and attend Mass on this date. It will be for our children in Year 1 – Year 6. Our children in Class 4 will be starting their swimming lessons on this day, so they will not be attending Mass on this occasion.

We always like to promote and encourage our children to take part in the reading challenge to ensure they continue to read regularly throughout the school holidays.

Harvest Liturgy

Our Diocesan theme this first term is *Encounter*. Bishop Patrick encourages schools across the Diocese to support the vulnerable and the homeless.
