

#### **CATHOLIC FOUNDATION STONES**

#### Exploring the basics of the Faith

The programme, 'Catholic Foundation Stones' is a basic introduction to the Catholic faith. It is free of charge open to all staff, directors and local governors in our schools, for example:

- Colleagues from all faith backgrounds or none who are interested in learning something about the Catholic faith;
- Colleagues who wish to deepen their knowledge of the Catholic faith;
- Colleagues who are returning to the practice of their faith;
- Colleagues who may be interested in becoming Catholics.

Catholic Foundation Stones is structured around the four pillars of the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

- The faith we profess (the Creed a statement of what we believe);
- The faith we celebrate (the Sacraments);
- The faith we live (the moral life);
- The faith we pray (prayer and the spiritual life).

The programme comprises twelve sessions in total which will be delivered throughout the academic year (four sessions per term). Sessions will last for one hour; they will be delivered informally and will include some input, time for reflection and prayer and opportunities to engage in discussion. Nobody will be tested or 'made' to contribute! (You will be able to join at any point during the year).

#### Session titles are as follows:

- Session 1 Introducing the Catholic Faith
- Session 2 God's Revelation and God the Father and Creator
- Session 3 God the Son: Jesus Christ
- Session 4 God the Holy Spirit; Mary and the Saints
- Session 5 The Church
- Session 6 Liturgy; the Liturgical Year and the Sacraments
- Session 7 The Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation
- Session 8 The Sacrament of the Eucharist
- Session 9 The Sacraments of Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick
- Session 10 The Sacraments of Marriage and Ordination
- Session 11 Living a Christian Life
- Session 12 Prayer



#### **CATHOLIC FOUNDATION STONES**

- An introduction to the Catholic faith for all members of staff, directors and local governors who would benefit from learning more about the faith that underpins the school in which they work
- Structured around the four sections of the Catechism of the Catholic Church
- An opportunity to further explore and discuss various aspects of the Catholic faith

#### MONITORING AND EVALUATING CATHOLIC LIFE AND MISSION

#### **Course Content / Overview**

If we place Catholicity at the heart of all we do in our schools, we need to know if we have, and, most importantly, if we are being successful at it. This is where the monitoring and evaluation of Catholic Life and Mission fits into the programme of activity for local governors.

The session will assist local governors to consider:

- The extent to which the mission of the school is known and understood by all members of the school family
- The commitment of leaders and local governors
- The school's priorities and the context of these
- Current and recent school improvement plans in relation to Catholic Life and Mission
- Professional development
- The support from, and partnership with, the parent body
- Response to and engagement with the diocese and parish/es
- The extent to which school policies and practices reflect the Catholic Life and Mission of the school
- How the school supports charities and acts to promote the principles of Catholic social teaching

#### Module structure

- Each Module should take no more than 20 minutes to complete
- You can choose to deepen your understanding on any particular Module through suggested further reading and links to other resources
- You can save your progress as you go along. That means you don't need to complete a module all in one go!

#### At the end of the course

- You'll understand the new statutory requirements for teaching Relationships, Sex and Health Education and some key principles for applying these in a Catholic context
- You'll have had the chance to think about how the new requirements relate to you and your pupils, as well as their parents
- You'll have been introduced to Catholic Educational material including a model curriculum cited as an example of good practice – and resource lessons that meet the new requirements




