

Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for, if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion, you should also complete a supplementary information form, and return this form to the school by the deadline (forms are available from the LA and the school). You MUST also include the supporting evidence as required with this form, e.g baptism certificate .(photocopies acceptable).
