



# Happy New Year!

Welcome back to the new Lent term! I hope you all had a good Christmas and New Year. We are pleased to welcome our children back to school today and are looking forward to their exciting learning challenges this term.

### **Catholic Life**

Today (January 8<sup>th</sup>), in union with the whole Church, we celebrate the great event that is the Baptism of the Lord. Today is also a great opportunity for us to remember our own or another family member's Baptism.

### Gospel of Luke (3:15-16, 21-22)

As the people were filled with expectation, and all were questioning in their hearts concerning John, whether he might be the Messiah, John answered all of them by saying, "I baptise you with water; but one who is more powerful than I is coming; I am not worthy to untie the thong of his sandals. He will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and fire."

Now, when all the people were baptised, and when Jesus also had been baptised and was praying, the heaven was opened, and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, *"You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased."* 

#### **Class Mass**

Father Richard continues to be in school most Fridays for Class Mass. This allows our children to get to know Father Richard and for them to start building a positive relationship with their Parish Priest. Each class is on a rota for celebrating Mass in their classroom and parents will be informed of when their child's Mass will be, as parents, carers and parishioners are welcome to attend. If you are not available to attend, grandparents or other family members are also welcome to join Class Masses.

#### **School Chaplain**

We continue to have our school Chaplain, Charles Archer, come in to school every other Thursday afternoon to support our children with their Prayer and Liturgy.

#### **First Holy Communion**

The date of the first meeting for parents is as follows and will be held at Holy Cross Church, Hucknall in the hall which is situated at the back of the Church. The meeting will take place tomorrow, **Tuesday 9th January at 6.00pm** in Holy Cross Church Hall.

#### Nursery

This term, we welcome another eight new children to our Nursery, totalling twenty children now in the Nursery. We are limited to twenty-six places, so please ask for an application pack if you would like your child to start after Easter. Your child can start in Nursery the term after they are three.

# School shoes / Trainers

Please ensure your child is wearing black school shoes and trainers **only for PE days**. We expect children to wear either black, navy or white trainers. Please do not send children to school in expensive branded or brightly coloured trainers.

We have a few children who have been coming into school wearing trainers when it is not their PE days. If you are waiting for new school shoes to arrive, please inform the office or your child's class teacher, as your child will be asked why they are wearing trainers if it is not a PE day.

# Termly Learning Meetings (Parents' evenings) and SEND reviews

Our termly learning meetings will take place at the beginning of next half term. We are offering our **online meetings on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> February** and **face to face meetings on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> February**. It is really important that parents are kept up to date with their children's academic progress at school and we value the learning partnership between school and home. Information about your child's attendance, behaviour, homework, achievements and next steps are always shared with parents during these meetings.

If your child has Special Educational Needs, Mrs Tipton is organising a separate timetable for parent meetings. If you are attending a SEND review, you **do not** need to also book a Termly Learning meeting. SEND reviews will be held week beginning **26**<sup>th</sup> **February**.
