On Friday 19th July will be celebrating International Food Day. We are inviting parents and carers to bring in food from different countries, countries that relate to your family, or which you may have associations with, have visited or are interested in.

Children may wear traditional clothing from their culture/background or they may come in colours related to the flag of their chosen country.

The day will be spent engaging in activities that celebrate Holy Cross's diversity. The children will learn key facts about the countries from which the food came from. We will use Google Earth to visit some of the countries and compare. We will listen to traditional music and there will be a variety of activities taking place throughout the day, including traditional arts and crafts, dancing and stories from other cultures. In the afternoon the children will have a picnic and be able to try the food!
