#### **OUTDOOR MASS AT OUR LADY'S**



Following the closure of the Convent in Bulwell, because it was unsafe for them to remain there, these two Sisters have been living temporarily in a parish property in Leicester. The bungalow here in Bulwell is their new, permanent home and I know that, as a parish, we will give them a warm welcome. The Poor Clares (Colettines) live in enclosure, their primary ministry is prayer, and so they will be a very welcome, prayerful presence in the parish. "
