<u>1.</u>	Covenant	a contract and promise made between a person and God.
<u>2.</u>	Genesis	The first book in the Bible and tells the creation story.
<u>3.</u>	Exodus	a book in the Bible that tells the story of how Moses set the Isarelites free from Egypt.
<u>4.</u>	Mount Sinai	the place where Moses received the Ten Commandments from God.
<u>5.</u>	The Ten Commandments	the ten rules given to Moses by God to dictate how humans should treat and live with each other.
<u>6.</u>	Rules	tell you what you are allowed and not allowed to do to and they are designed to keep you safe.
<u>7.</u>	Sin	deliberately spoiling our friendship with God and each other.
<u>8.</u>	Conscience	the part of you that judges how moral your own actions are and it makes you feel guilty for any bad things you have done.
<u>9.</u>	Morals	what a person believes to be right and wrong.
<u>10.</u>	Virtue	a good habit of behaviour, showing a high moral standard.
<u>11.</u>	Cardinal virtues	four moral virtues of mind and character: prudence, justice, fortitude and temperance.
<u>12.</u>	Theological virtues	faith, hope and charity (love).
<u>13.</u>	Justice	all people are treated fairly.
<u>14.</u>	Prudence	using good judgement when making a decision or taking action.

The Ten Commandments

	The Commandment	What it means:
1	You shall have no other gods before me.	Having another 'god' isn't as simple as worshipping a different God. Anything you put above God, even if it's just money or people is wrong.
2	You shall make no graven images	Don't worship idols; you should only worship God. Like the First Commandment, God should be the most important thing in your life.
3	You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.	God's name is special. Don't misuse it.
4	Keep the Sabbath day holy.	The Hebrew work shabbath means 'rest.' Remember to take time to rest and focus on God.
5	Honor your father and your mother.	Respect your parents.
6	You shall not murder.	Don't kill anyone on purpose of unlawfully.
7	You shall not commit adultery.	Respect husbands and wives. If you get married, keep your promises to each other.
8	You shall not steal.	Don't take something that doesn't belong to you.
9	You shall not give false testimony against your neighbour.	Tell the truth and don't make up lies about people.
<u>10</u>	Do not desire another man's house, wife, cattle or anything that he owns.	Be content with what you already have. Don't crave what doesn't belong to you.
