DEACON MARTYN SWABY RIP

It is with great sadness that we share news of the sudden passing of Reverend Deacon Martyn Swaby on Tuesday 28th April 2026. Since joining our parish as a Deacon on 12th May 2013, Martyn was a dedicated servant whose absence will be profoundly felt by everyone. During his years with us, and whilst also working as a Mental Health Chaplain for the NHS, Deacon Martyn touched many lives—baptising children, officiating at weddings, conducting funerals, and leading sacramental programmes within the parish. He will especially be remembered for founding the Mind to be Merciful Cafe, offering comfort and support to so many people. Prior to joining the Diaconate, Martyn, along with his family, was a longstanding parishioner of Our Lady's and a Governor from the early 2000's, as well as being a great supporter of the Friends of the School. Deacon Martyn played an important role at Our Lady's school, visiting each week and serving as Chair of Governors. His cheeky sense of humour and genuine kindness made him cherished and respected throughout our parish community. Martyn has been a great help and support to myself since arriving in the parish, going above and beyond whilst I was unwell. I will miss our conversations and his quirky sense of humour. Martyn was truly a pillar within our parish and local school, and his legacy of compassion and service will be long remembered. His commitment leaves an enduring mark on all those who knew him, and he will be greatly missed. Please pray for the repose of the soul of Martyn and we remember and pray especially for his wife Toni, son Jack, daughter Emma, Anthony, Emma's fiancé and family during this difficult time.

Deacon Martyn's reception into church will be on Wednesday 27th May at 6.30pm and Requiem Mass will be on Thursday 28th May at 10.00am. May his kind and gentle soul Rest in Peace. Eternal rest grant unto him O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him. May he rest in peace. Amen
